Site Carpentry & Bench Joinery

The Site Carpentry and Bench Joinery Apprenticeships provide a rounded training experience for young people employed in the construction industry as carpenters or joiners. And covers a broad range of training preparing you for work on different types of sites from private houses to large building sites

What do I learn?

An Apprenticeship qualification includes several elements and you will need to pass all elements to gain your Apprenticeship.



Level 2 Construction Diploma National Vocational Qualification (NVQ)

Employment Rights and Responsibilities training, and L1 Functional Skills in English and Math's

You will study units such as:

- Conform to general workspace safety
- Conform to efficient work practices
- Move and handle resources.
- Erect structural carcassing components
- Maintain non-structural carpentry work
- Set-up and use circular saws
- Produce setting out details for routine products
- Manufacture routine products.



L3 Diploma in Site Carpentry or Bench Joinery

This is an advanced course which gives learner a broader base of knowledge and experience to prepare you for working within the construction industry.

What do I learn?

Over the one-year programme you learn the advanced theory of site carpentry and gain the practical skills and experience necessary to progress in this industry or related areas.
